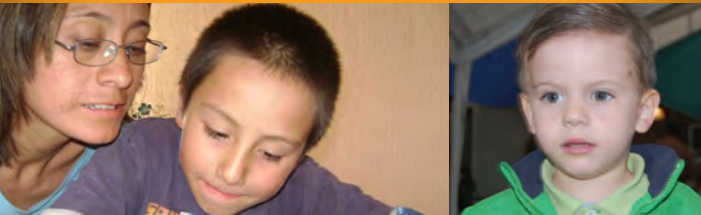


# OBJECTIVES
